

BLASTBALL!

Rules and Regulations

Blastball is played with approximately 8 players per team; however, games may be played with fewer players if needed. No official score will be kept during Blastball games.

A batter is considered safe and “earns a run” if they reach the Blast Base before a defensive player fields the ball and yells “BLAST.” If a defensive player fields or catches the ball and yells “BLAST” before the batter reaches the Blast Base, the batter is out.

Each game will last either 4 innings or 45 minutes, whichever comes first. During each inning, both teams will have an opportunity to bat and field. Every player on the batting team will bat once before teams switch roles. An inning ends after the final batter completes their turn.

Gloves and cleats are optional but not required to participate.

When the ball is hit, it must stay in bounds and travel beyond the Fair Line Arc to be considered in play. If the ball does not pass the arc, it is considered foul, and the batter will hit again. There are no balls, strikes, or strikeouts in Blastball. Coaches may assist batters after the third swing.

Parents are encouraged to assist players and coaches when necessary. Coaches will serve as umpires during the game.

King William County Parks and Recreation will provide all equipment including bats, bases, balls, and tees needed to play.
